

The City Council of the City of Princeton, Iowa met in a budget work session on Thursday, December 13, 2018 at 6:44 p.m. in the Council Chambers at Princeton City Hall. Council members reviewed the preliminary budget numbers for expenses for FY 2020. Police Chief Carsten reviewed his budget with Council. Council discussed adding money into the budget for the new well and an addition to the public works building. Council discussed rec trail money. Mayor Woomert explained how Fire District 1 payments work and how they are part of the Fire Department budget but does not come from the City.
