NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED PLANS, SPECIFICATIONS, FORM OF CONTRACT AND ESTIMATED TOTAL COST OF PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF WWTP SOLAR PROJECT FOR THE CITY OF PRINCETON, IOWA

The Council of the City of Princeton will meet at the City Hall, on the 10th day of April 2025 at 6:00 P.M., at which time and place, a hearing will be held on the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract, and estimated total cost of public improvement for the construction of the Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) Solar Project. At said hearing, the Council will consider said plans and specifications, proposed form of contract and the estimate of cost for the project, the same now being on file in the office of the Clerk, reference to which is made for a more detailed and complete description of the proposed work, and at said time and place the said Council will also receive and consider any objections to said plans, specifications and form of contract or cost of such project made by any interested party.

The nature and extent of the improvements are as follows:

### **Wastewater Treatment Plant (WWTP) Solar Project**

“This project involves the installation of Solar panels for the City of Princeton’s Wastewater treatment plant located at the Northeast corner of 285th Ave and Great River Rd, near the railroad tracks across from the wastewater treatment plant lagoons. This work shall include, and is not limited to, the clearing and grubbing of the designated area, the installation of all required electrical work for proper performance, railroad permitting and right of way work, installation of steel frames, panels, and inverter; seeding and miscellaneous work associated with the project including cleanup.

After hearing objections, the City of Princeton shall by resolution enter its decision on the plans, specifications, contract, and estimated cost.
