months needed to be licensed, by March
31, 2019. Please **do not** include your
dog license fee in with your utility
payment. Please make out a separate
check or cash for accounting purposes.
After March 31st, 2019, there is a
\$10.00 per month penalty for not
registering your dog.

Golf Cart Registrations are due for
the summer. All carts must have proof
of insurance. They are licensed through
the City from January – December for
\$10. Must be 16 years old and have a
legal drivers' license to operate a cart.
